With this in mind, we have carefully considered what we can reasonably expect of each other:

OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

- We will respect your personal decisions and allow you to make your own decisions about what activity you can carry out. However, we ask you not to undertake an activity which is beyond what you consider to be your own ability.
- We will make every reasonable effort to make sure that our equipment and facilities are in a safe condition for you to use and enjoy.
- We will take all reasonable steps to make sure that our staff are qualified to the industry standards.
- If you tell us that you have a disability which puts you at a substantial disadvantage in accessing our equipment and facilities, we will consider what adjustments are reasonable for us to make.

YOUR COMMITMENT TO US

- You should not undertake an activity that is beyond your own ability. If you know or are concerned that you have a medical condition which might interfere with using the facility safely before you use our equipment and facilities, you should get advice from a relevant medical professional and follow that advice.
- You should make yourself aware of any rules and instructions, including warning notices.
- You should not carry out any activities which you have been told are not suitable for you.
- You should let us know immediately if you feel ill when using our equipment or facilities. Our staff members are not qualified doctors, but there will be a person available who has had first-aid training.

SNOWSPORT CODE OF CONDUCT

Skiing & Boarding has inherent risks and hazards, the nature of this sport means that self-awareness and self-responsibility are paramount. Gloves are always worn and arms and legs covered; this is mandatory. Helmets are recommended but not mandatory, it is the users' choice which head covering, if any, they wear.

Self-Responsibility - Be aware ski & board with care.

Respect For Others - Be aware of all other Skiers and Boarders close to you and do not endanger them.

Control of Speed - Ski and Board within the extent of your abilities, making sure you can stop safely at any time.

Choice of Route - Select your descent responsibly so that you do not endanger yourself and / or others.

Overtaking - The lower skier / boarder has the right of way, when passing give plenty of space to others.

Entering the Slope - Do so slowly, looking up the slope first, being aware of those above and below you.

Stopping - If you must come to a halt do so at the side of the slope, not in the middle.

Moving Uphill - Do so always at the side of the slope facing other skiers & boarders.

Signs and Markings - Take notice of signs, their message is important to your safety.

Helping Others - Snowsports are social activities where concern and respect for others prevails.
